Let's sharpen our swords!

I sense that the Lord is calling us take some time to sharpen our swords!

I had a picture of a man who was using an old grinder to sharpen his sword that was very rusty, but as soon as he started sharpening the sword all the rust disappeared and the sword became shiny again. After that he started wielding the sword and the sword caught fire, and tongues of fire were swung into the Land and all over the Land small fires were started, which grew rapidly.

I was reminded that in Ezra, it is written that through the prophetic word of the prophets, the people of God were encouraged to build the house of God! Ezra 5:1-2: "Now the prophets, Haggai the prophet, and Zechariah the son of Iddo, prophesied unto the Jews that were in Judah and Jerusalem; in the name of the God of Israel [they prophesied] unto them. Then rose up Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and began to build the house of God which is at Jerusalem; and with them were the prophets of God, helping them."

God wants us to take our sword, which in this case is the personal revelatory rhema word the Lord has given us, and sharpen it! Where through time and circumstances this word has become rusty, we need to take the old grinder (which is the spiritual discipline God has given us in the past; praying, fasting, seeking the Lord, etc.) and sharpen it again. It is time to get a fresh revelation on that which the Lord has already shown you!

I believe it isn't the time to seek the Lord for a new word, but to sharpen and put into practice that which the Lord has already spoken.

This sharpening will come forth out of a rest position. While resting, we give the Spirit the opportunity to refresh that which the Lord has revealed to us before. Through these reactivated words God wants to release a fire over the Land that will result in a growth and a building of the house of the Lord. I saw a new zeal and equipping to plant new churches.
